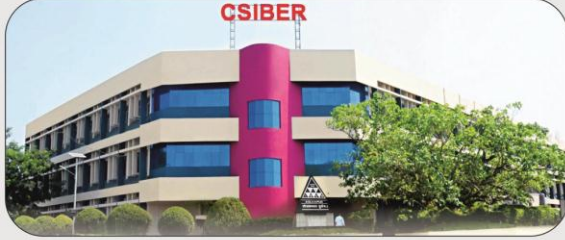

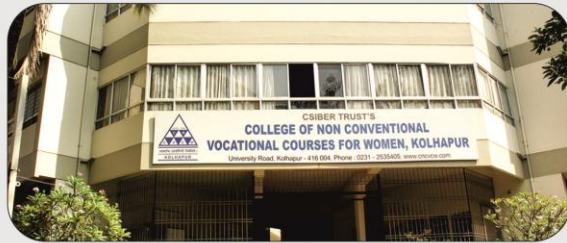

22.0 LIBRARY ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

The Library serves the new students and new staff members by providing course-related library orientation sessions. Students receive focused assistance from library staff to learn how to find, evaluate and use the library resources and other information to complete course assignments and other curricular needs.

The Institute's Library has **5587** books as on 31st March 2019. The Library has provided open access facility to the all students, staff, in the academic year 2018-19. The library has spent Rs. **2,28,320/-** on the purchase of **434** books along with this **13** are donated and complementary books. **28 Periodicals** are subscribed **Rs. 43,750/-** and an amount of **Rs. 7,106/-** has been spent on **Daily News papers**. The total expenditure of the library in 2018-19 on knowledge resources is Rs. **2,79,176/-**

कोल्हापूर : हेल्दी (आरोग्यदायी) असूनही केवळ उग्र वासामुळे शेपू या भाजीला अनेकजण नाक मुरडतात. मात्र, आता त्यांना 'शेपू'ची भाजी खाकऱ्याच्या स्वरूपात खाता येणार आहे. कोल्हापुरातील श्रद्धा कुलकर्णी यांनी संशोधनातून पौष्टिक खाकऱ्याचा पर्याय उपलब्ध करून दिला आहे.

येथील छत्रपती शाहू इन्स्टिट्यूट ऑफ बिझनेस एज्युकेशन अँड रिसर्च (सायबर) ट्रस्टच्या कॉलेज ऑफ नॉन-कन्व्हेंशियल व्होकेशनल कोर्सेस फॉर वुमेनमध्ये सहायक प्राध्यापिकापदी कुलकर्णी कार्यरत आहेत. या महाविद्यालयातील फूड टेक्नॉलॉजी अँड मॅनेजमेंट विभागात पोषणशास्त्र

त्यांनी हे संशोधन डिसेंबर २०१७ मध्ये झालेल्या शिवाजी विद्यापीठातील आविष्कार संशोधन महोत्सवात पहिल्यांदा सादर केले. खाकरा हा गुजरातमधील प्रसिद्ध पदार्थ असला, तरी महाराष्ट्रातही तो आवडीने खाण्यात येतो. खाकरा हा साधारणतः गव्हाचे पीठ वापरून केला जातो.

खाण्यास पौष्टिक

श्वसनाचे विकार कमी करणे, महिलांच्या मासिक धमचि नियमन, हाडांचे आरोग्य, रोगप्रतिकारक्षमता वाढविणे, आदींबाबत शेपू उपयुक्त ठरणार आहे. मात्र, केवळ शेपूचा उग्र वास येत असल्याने तिचे सेवन करणे अनेकजण टाळतात. आरोग्यदृष्ट्या पौष्टिक असणाऱ्या या शेपूचे सेवन वाढावे, या उद्देशातून शेपूच्या वापरातून खाकरा तयार केला असल्याचे कुलकर्णी यांनी सांगितले. त्या म्हणाल्या, सहा महिन्यांच्या संशोधनातून हा खाकरा साकारला

मात्र, शेपूपासून बनविलेल्या खाकऱ्यामध्ये गव्हाच्या पिठासह बाजरी, बेसनाचे पीठही वापरले आहे. बाजरीमध्ये तंतुमय पदार्थांचे प्रमाण

आहे. यातील काही संशोधनासाठी माझ्या विद्यार्थिनींचीही मदत झाली. शेपू आणि गहू, बाजरी व बेसनाचे पीठ, आले, लसूण, मिरची पेस्ट व मीठ एकत्र करून नेहमीप्रमाणे हा पौष्टिक खाकरा तयार करावा. या खाकऱ्यातून शरीरासाठी उपयुक्त असणारी प्रथिने, कॅल्शियम (ऊर्जा), फायबर, कॅल्शियम, फॉस्फरस आणि लोह चांगल्या प्रमाणात मिळते. हवाबंद डब्यात ठेवल्यास हा खाकरा एक महिना टिकतो.

अधिक असते. गव्हातून ऊर्जा, प्रथिने तसेच बेसनमधूनही चांगले प्रथिने मिळतात. त्यामुळे हा खाकरा पौष्टिक ठरणारा आहे.
