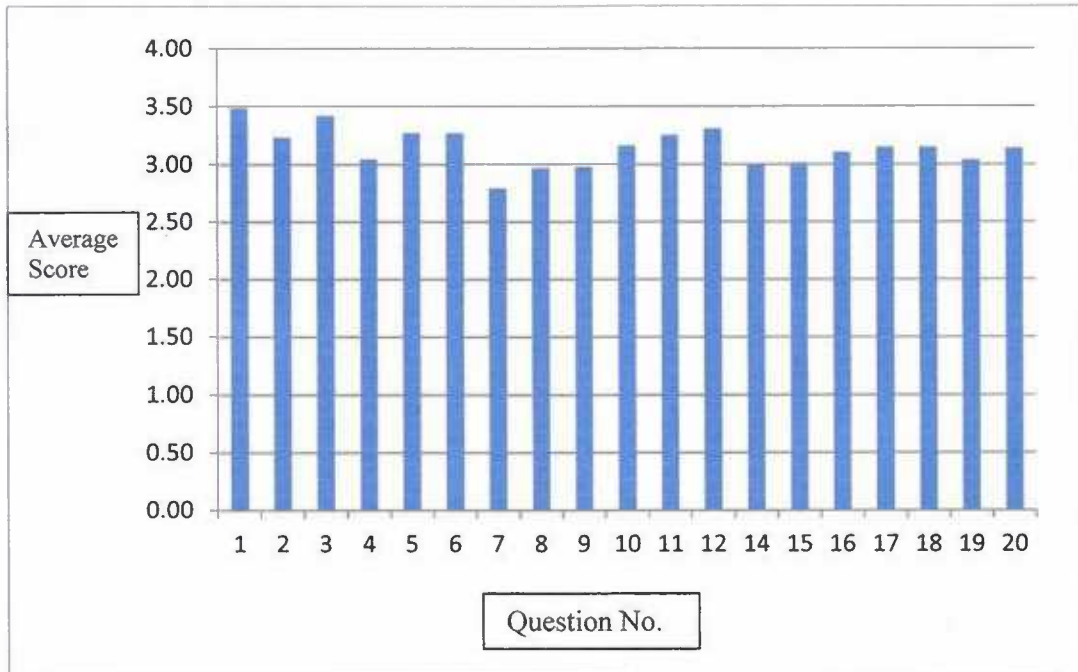

2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey 2023-24

- For the academic year 2023-24, Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted online through Google form. The questionnaire was formulated as per the Guidelines provided by NAAC. format through Google form.
- As per requirement, Final year students of all departments were taken as respondents. A total of 132 (68%) students out of 192 responded the survey.
- Students rated questions on a scale ranging from 0 (Least Satisfied) to 4 (Highly Satisfied).
- **Result of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) = 3.15 (On a scale of 4)**
