WHEREAS

1. Scope of the MoU

- g) Any other areas of co-operation as mutually agreed to by the Parties from time to time.

2. DURATION AND TERMINATION

This MoU shall remain in effect for FIVE (5) years from the effective date or until terminated by either party with thirty (30) days written notice.

This MoU may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

3. FINANCIAL AGREEMENT

This MoU shall not give rise to any financial obligation to CNCVCW CSIBER or Kalapuri Foundation unless the CSIBER Trust Management approves it.

This MoU shall not give rise to any financial obligation to any of the parties unless the owner approves it.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

Each party shall undertake to observe the secrecy of confidential information received from or supplied to the other Party during the period of implementation of this MoU or other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.

5. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTS

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU shall first be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the parties. In the event of non-resolution, reference shall be made to a mediator jointly appointed by the Parties who shall mediate the dispute or difference in question.

6. NON CONTRACTUAL NATURE AND AMENDMENT

The Parties acknowledge that this MoU does not in way give rise to any right or permission to use or to be associated with each Party's intellectual property. Any and every outcome of joint project work or projects shall be intellectual property of the Party which initiated the project and shall be treated as confidential.

7. REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

Either Party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this MoU. Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall from part of this MoU. Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.

Any revision; variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

8. SUPERVISING EVENTS

Each Party reserves the right for reasons of national security, national interests, public order or public health to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implantation of this MoU which suspension shall take effect immediately after notification has been given to the other Party.

Notwithstanding sub-clause 8 above should any other event occur which hinders or restricts the implantation of this MoU, the Parties shall use their best endeavour to agree upon such action, as may be necessary and equitable, to remove the cause of such event.
