

- 3. Water conservation through rain water harvesting and waste water recycling:
 The rainwater collected from college roof top is collected by means of pipes and it is
 used for ground water recharge. The waste water collected from washrooms is
 recycled with common Sewage Treatment Plant and it is used for landscaping.
- 4. Use of solar energy and LED tube light: Solar panels are installed on college rooftop to promote use of renewable energy resources. Total 46 solar panels are installed with capacity of 15 kw. Along with this, 194 LED tubes and 36 LED panels are used in college for conservation of energy. It also helps to reduce carbon footprints.
- Restricted entry of automobiles:
 Vehicles are not allowed in college campus which is a step taken for clean air initiative.
- 6. Environmental, Green and energy audit:
 Green and energy audit is conducted every year in college. It helps to review and
 improve environmental performance of college. These audits acts as tool to evaluate
 how energy and water resources are used in college. It helps to promote eco-friendly
 practices in campus. Energy audit helps to reduce carbon footprints of college.
- 7. Nature club:

Nature club is established in college and various activities are undertaken in college including Eco-friendly god Ganesha idol making, Eco-friendly rakhi making, e-waste collection drive etc.

Nature club performs various activities in collaboration with Dept. of Environment Science.



4.2 Scope of Green Initiative in Terms Of Environmental Aspects:

- Energy Conservation: Energy conservation is the effort made to reduce the consumption of energy by using less of an energy service. This can be achieved either by using energy more efficiently (using less energy for a constant service) or by reducing the amount of service used.
- ➤ Use of Renewable Energy: Renewable energy is useful energy that is collected from renewable resources, which are naturally replenished on a human timescale, including carbon neutral sources like sunlight, wind, rain, tides, waves, and geothermal heat.
- Fifforts for Carbon Neutrality: carbon-neutral (or carbon neutrality) is the balance between emitting carbon and absorbing carbon emissions from carbon sinks.
- > Plantation: It is usually large group of plants and especially trees under cultivation
- Water Management: Water management is the control and movement of water resources to minimize damage to life and property and to maximize efficient beneficial use.
- Hazardous Waste management: Hazardous waste management involves reducing the amount of hazardous substances produced, treating hazardous wastes to reduce their toxicity, and applying sound engineering controls to reduce or eliminate exposures to these wastes.
- ➤ E-Waste Management: E-waste or Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment are loosely discarded, surplus, obsolete, broken, electrical or electronic devices
- Quality of water, air and noise: Air pollution and excessive noise harm our health and our environment. Water quality describes the condition of the water, including chemical, physical, and biological characteristics, usually with respect to its suitability for a particular purpose such as drinking or swimming.



5. PLANTATION:

- In order to create awareness among students, plantation is carried out from time to time. The environment department of college is taking continuous efforts to increase the green cover in college campus.
- Plantation consists of different types of shady and flowering trees.
- Ornamental plants are planted in soil pots, which are placed in corridors.
- Proper care of all these plants is taken by gardener.
