2. Basic Information of the Programme

B. A. in Dress Making and Fashion coordination

This is a skill based programme catering to the needs of Fashion Industry. It promotes & develops entrepreneurs in fashion & fashion related business. The programme prepares the student through a variety of techniques, media & approaches in the challenging assignments to create a fashion Designer. Fashion designers create original clothing, accessories, and footwear. They sketch designs, select fabrics and patterns, and give instructions on how to make the products they design.

- **Admission Process**

Admission to the aspiring students will be given purely based on qualifying previous examination the Govt. of Maharashtra and adopted by Shivaji University Kolhapur from time to time.

- **Eligibility**

Admission to First Year

A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of Maharashtra State Board or (10+2) Diploma Fashion Design Government (D.D.G.M) M.S.B.T.E./ I.T.I/M.C.V.C./Textile / Handloom Department of Technical Education any Examination of any Statutory University with Science, Arts, Commerce or Vocational streams OR.MCVC Students can get admission only by submitting the government equivalence certificate. Students coming from Examination Board other than the HSC Examination Board Maharashtra, should obtain an 'Eligibility certificate' from the Registrar, Shivaji University for being considered for admission for 1 year.

Admission to Direct Second Year/ Lateral Admissions

Candidate (10+3) Diploma-D.D.G.M-M.S.B.T.E./I.T.I /M.C.V.C./Textile / Handloom conducted by the Technical Education or Department of Technical Education any Examination of any State Statutory University. With (10+3) Diploma in Textile Technology in Costume and Fashion Design conducted by the Department of Technical Education of any State is eligible for admission (Related to Fashion Design Subjects.) Direct to the Second year of the B.A. (DMFC) degree course. Candidates with a Diploma (10+3) in Handloom Technology and Diploma in Handloom and Textiles conducted by the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India are also eligible for admission directly to the Second Year B.A. (DMFC) degree course.

- **Duration of the course.**

The course of study for the degree B. A. in Dress Making and Fashion Coordination shall be a full-time course extending to three academic years i.e. six Semesters consisting of 90 days of instruction per semester. A candidate who fails to complete the course within a period of three years should complete the course within six years from the date of joining the course.

- **Medium of Instruction.**

The medium of instruction shall be in English.

- **Dress Code**

There is a Dress code for the students for three days in a week i.e Monday, Wednesday and Friday

- **Examination**

The examinations will be conducted by Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

Total marks allotted for the theory paper shall be 50 in which 40 marks will be for External written exam and 10 for Internal Exam. Total marks allotted for the practical paper shall be 50 marks including 15 marks for External assessment. Total marks for Term work shall be 50 marks. Head of passing for Written Exam, Internal assessment, Term work, Practical Exam and External Exam will be separate.

- **Standard of Passing**

To pass the examination a candidate must obtain a minimum of 35 % of marks in each paper subject. A candidate should pass a minimum of 2/3rd. of the subjects of each year i.e. both semester including Internal assessment, Theory exam, Practical exam and External assessment. If a candidate fails to pass the minimum of 2/3rd of the subject she will not be allowed to take admission to the next year.

- **Internship Project**

A student should undergo 30 days Internship training in a Garment unit/ Designer house/ Buying house/ Textile processing Unit/ Retail house/ Designer Boutiques or any firm related to Fashion Designing. This internship has to be done after 2nd year i.e. after fourth semester examination before the beginning of the Fifth semester. Total marks allotted for Internship report will be in the IIIrd year shall be 200 marks out of which 100 marks will be Internal report Assessment and 100 marks for External Internship report assessment and viva – voce at the end of the year.

8. Students Grievance Redressel Committee (SGRC)

10. General Instructions

- Candidate should carefully read the prospectus issued by the Institute, Instructions as well as the relevant University publications. - Candidates are admitted to the course, subject to the rules of Shivaji University, Kolhapur as to the eligibility, grant of terms etc.
- The fees prescribed by the University for the Course must be paid at the time of admission. Failure to do so shall result in cancellation of admission.
- If a candidate is entitled to any Government Scholarship or Free ship, the amount of such scholarship or free ship will be paid to him / her only when it is actually received by the Institute from the appropriate authorities.
- For the grant of two terms and for eligibility to fill in the University Examination Form of the course, candidate must attend at least 80% of the lectures for the course as laid down by the University.
- No candidate shall be considered to have pursued course of study unless he / she is certified by the Principal to have attended at least 80% of the lectures and satisfactorily completed all the tutorials, seminars and internal work as laid down by the University.
- Every candidate must attend the classes regularly and complete her class work, tutorials, Practical's, Assignments Seminars and Displays within the stipulated period. Attendance for periodical test and surprise tests conducted from time to time is compulsory.
- All the submissions with respect to the internal marks have to be done in the allotted time only. Late submissions are not allowed.
- The students will be exposed to the Fashion industry and related fields through
- constant liaison and interaction with the industry and faculty from this field
- A very high standard of discipline, regularity and punctuality is expected from the candidates, failure of which will be viewed seriously in judging the performance of a candidate.
- No candidate shall be allowed to appear for the University Examination unless she

satisfies all the rules and regulations laid down by the University.

- Fees are not refundable on any account except the amounts paid as Library Deposit and Caution Money. Whenever admission of a student is to be cancelled by her, the student should intimate to the Principal in writing, with the written consent of her guardian.
- The students are required to be in the prescribed dress code on the campus on the stipulated days and when the occasions demand.
- The code of conduct as laid down by the Institute is required to be strictly followed by the students.
