2. Basic Information of the Programme

B. A. in Dress Making and Fashion coordination

This is a skill based programme catering to the needs of Fashion Industry. It promotes & develops entrepreneurs in fashion & fashion related business. The programme prepares the student through a variety of techniques, media & approaches in the challenging assignments to create a fashion Designer. Fashion designers create original clothing, accessories, and footwear. They sketch designs, select fabrics and patterns, and give instructions on how to make the products they design.

Admission Process

Admission to the aspiring students will be given purely based on qualifying previous examination the Govt. of Maharashtra and adopted by Shivaji University Kolhapur from time to time.

Eligibility

Admission to First Year

A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of Maharashtra State Board or(10+2)Diploma Fashion Design Government (D.D.G.M) M.S.B.T.E./I.T.I/M.C.V.C./Textile / Handloom Department of Technical Education any Examination of any Statutory University with Science, Arts, Commerce or Vocational streams OR.MCVC Students can get admission only by submitting the government equivalencecertificate. Students coming from Examination Board other than the HSC Examination Board Maharashtra, should obtain an 'Eligibility certificate' from the Registrar, Shivaji University for being considered for admission for Iyear.

The course of study for the degree B. A. in Dress Making and Fashion Coordination shall be a full-time course extending to three academic years i.e. six Semesters consisting of 90 days of instruction per semester. Examination

The examinations will be conducted by Shivaji University, Kolhapur.

Total marks allotted for the theory paper shall be 50 in which40 marks will be for External written exam and10 for Internal Exam. Total marks allotted for the practical paper shall be 50 marks including 15 marks for External assessment. Total marks for Term work shall be 50 marks. Head of passing for Written Exam, Internal assessment, Term work, Practical Exam and External Exam will be separate.

Standard of Passing

To pass the examination a candidate must obtain a minimum of 35 % of marks in each paper subject. A candidate should pass a minimum of 2/3rd. of the subjects of each year i.e. both semester including Internal assessment, Theory exam, Practical exam and External assessment. If a candidate fails to pass the minimum of 2/3rd of the subject she will not be allowed to take admission to the next year.

• Internship Project

A student should undergo 30 days Internship training in a Garment unit/ Designer house/ Buying house/ Textile processing Unit/ Retail house/ Designer Boutiques or any firm related to Fashion Designing. This internship has to be done after 2nd year i.e. after fourth semester examination before the beginning of the Fifth semester. Total marks allotted for Internship report will be in the IIIrd year shall be 200 marks out of which 100 marks will be Internal report Assessment and 100 marks for External Internship report assessment and viva – voce at the end of the year.
