

Business transacted in the meeting held on 18th April 2023 is as follows:

Agenda 1 To read and confirm minutes of the meeting held on 6th December 2022.

Ag 2: To take a note on the result of NAAC- Re-accréditation 4th cycle of the college.

Action: The member secretary & Principal Prof. (Dr.) V. S. Dhekale reported all the CDC members about the NAAC - grade received for the 4th cycle i.e. B++ with 2.97 CGPA. Further, he also added that the CGPA of college has progressed from 2.79 for 3rd cycle of NAAC to 2.97 for the 4th cycle (Annexure I)

Ag 3: To discuss the schedule of college in two shifts for various programmes from academic year 2023-24.

Action: Prof. (Dr.) V. S. Dhekale suggested that the college can be run in two shifts i.e. Morning and afternoon. Programmes like B.Sc (Env. Sci), B.Com. (Bank mgt.) and B.A. (Multimedia) can be conducted in the morning shift i.e. 7:30 am - 1:30 pm. The other programmes like B.Sc. (Food Tech. & Mgt.), B.A. (DMFC), Bachelor of Interior Design, M.Sc (Food Sci & Nutrition) and PGDND can be conducted in afternoon shifts i.e. 10:30 am - 4:30 pm.

It was unanimously resolved to work out the above mentioned shifts with the time-table for various programmes which will be followed after the approval from management.

Ag 4: To take a note on construction of 3rd floor of college

Committee, Shivaji University Kolhapur (Annexure II); there is need for the construction of two separate well-equipped laboratories for M.Sc. (Food Sci & N). Considering the above recommendations, CDC members unanimously proposed the need of construction of 3rd floor of college to the management.

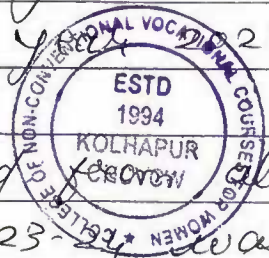
