

2.3.1 - Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies are used for enhancing learning experiences.

The overall development of students is emphasized in student-centered methods, and faculty stress the importance of 'conceptual clarity', despite the medium of instruction being English faculty explain difficult concepts in local language as students come from rural background. In the process of teaching and learning, demonstration techniques and ICT tools are utilized. Experimental Learning - College emphasizes the empowerment of women.

All departments promote students to link theoretical concepts with practical experiences through internships, field visits and projects. In the communication skills viva, assignments are given to the students to increase fluency of English in students. As an Add-on Course, foreign language is included for the first year students. Participative learning –Students are encouraged to participate in every departmental event, such as a seminar, group discussion, wall paper display, or project skill based add on courses . After the lecture, a short question-answer session is held in the classroom to clear students' doubt. Problem solving Method-Case studies are given to students to help them apply their skills and knowledge of learned facts to a real world situation in a practical manner.

Promoting students' vertical growth can be achieved through the use of Participatory learning, experimental learning, and problem-solving methods.

Report of Common Effluent Treatment Plant Visit


The Department of Environment Science, CNCVCW Conducted a visit of B.Sc. (Environment Science) I & III year Students to Common Effluent Treatment Plant on 27th December 2022. The Purpose behind the visit was to provide knowledge to the students about various Process involve in Effluent Treatment Plant.


Population growth – coupled with industrialization, urbanization has resulted in an increasing demand for water. Thus, leading to water crisis and serious consequence on the environment. A rapid industrialization has lead to the industrial effluent and sewage. The effluent stream coming out of the industries is mainly comprised of the hazardous chemical and heavy metal ions. These contents are very toxic in nature and harmful to the environment. Water are normally treated by combination of physical, chemical biological operator. This CETP collects the effluent form four different industries located in this area which are as SOKTAS, RAYMOND ZOMBAITI, INDOCOUNT, and OSWAL. Effluent from the industries shall be collected by MIDC and send to CETP by gravity and at some places by raising main through a timeline to the CETP waste water collection. Common effluent treatment plant (CETP) not only helps the industries in easier control of pollution, but also act as a step towards cleaner environment and service to the society at large.

During Visit Session , Students were informed about various process carried out in Common Effluent Treatment Plant- Primary , secondary and Tertiary. Students also interact with the people.

It was very helpful visit for students.

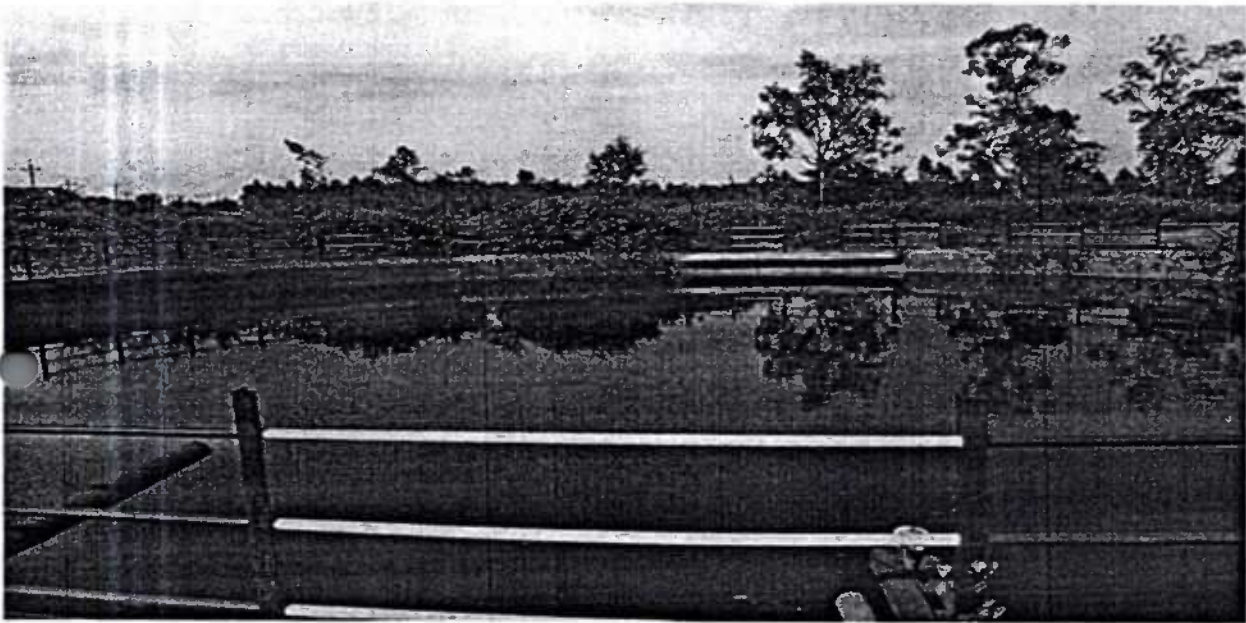

Report of Common Effluent Treatment Plant Visit

The Department of Environment Science, CNCVCW Conducted a visit of B.Sc. (Environment Science) I & III year Students to Common Effluent Treatment Plant on 27th December 2022. The Purpose behind the visit was to provide knowledge to the students about various Process involve in Effluent Treatment Plant.


Population growth – coupled with industrialization, urbanization has resulted in an increasing demand for water. Thus, leading to water crisis and serious consequence on the environment. A rapid industrialization has lead to the industrial effluent and sewage. The effluent stream coming out of the industries is mainly comprised of the hazardous chemical and heavy metal ions. These contents are very toxic in nature and harmful to the environment. Water are normally treated by combination of physical, chemical biological operator. This CETP collects the effluent form four different industries located in this area which are as SOKTAS, RAYMOND ZOMBAITI, INDOCOUNT, and OSWAL. Effluent from the industries shall be collected by MIDC and send to CETP by gravity and at some places by raising main through a timeline to the CETP waste water collection. Common effluent treatment plant (CETP) not only helps the industries in easier control of pollution, but also act as a step towards cleaner environment and service to the society at large.

During Visit Session , Students were informed about various process carried out in Common Effluent Treatment Plant- Primary , secondary and Tertiary. Students also interact with the people.

It was very helpful visit for students.

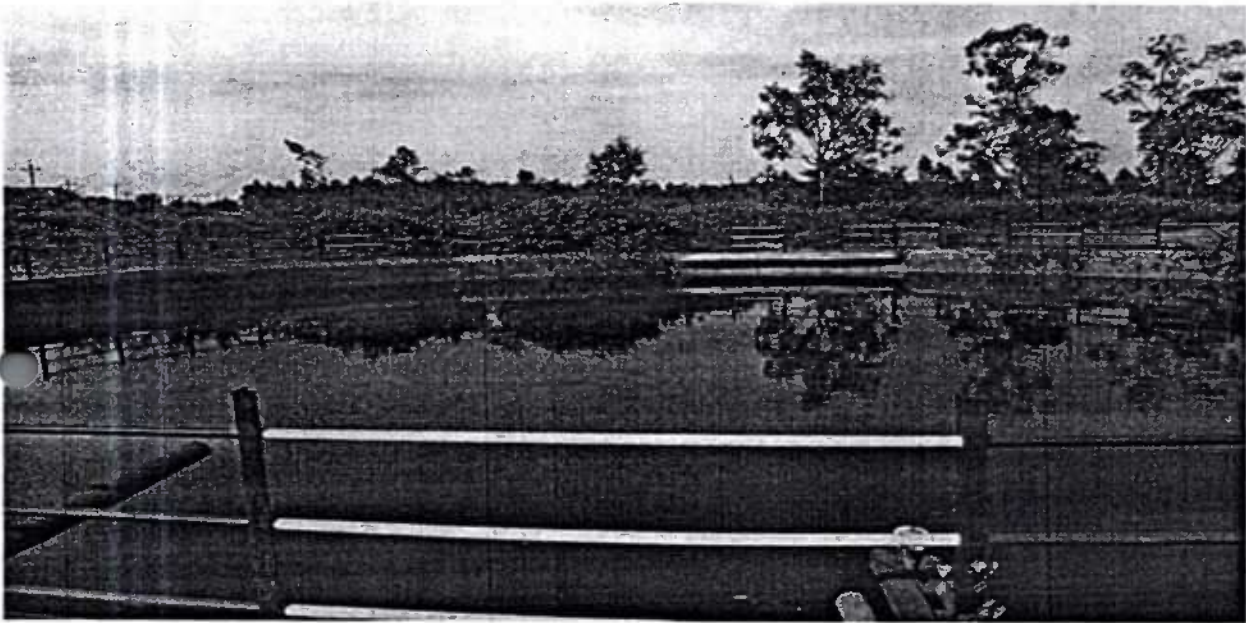
