- The responses were taken on 5 point scale for interpreting data and five classes were considered.

- The average score on all the questions was 70.02% that indicates very good responses on teachimng learning process.
- The data with two highest scores of 73.66% and 70.91% reveals Good communication of teachers with students and discussion of assignments in the class with students respectively.
- The dat with two lowest scores of 66.67% and 67.87% indicates teachers must prepare well for their classes and improve the mentoring process.
