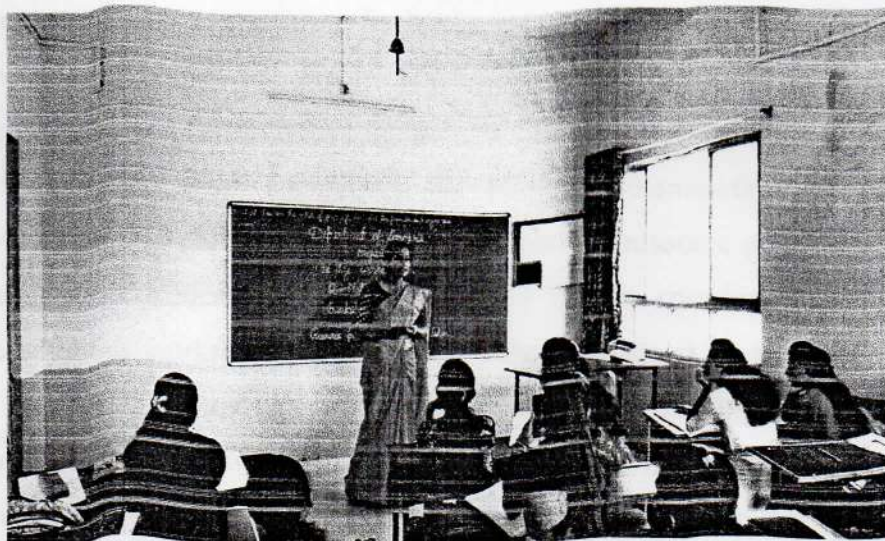

7th June 2022

A career counseling session, 'Scope in M.Sc. (Food Science and Nutrition)' was arranged by Food Technology Department on 7th June 2022 at 11.00 am for the B.Sc. (FTM) III-year students.

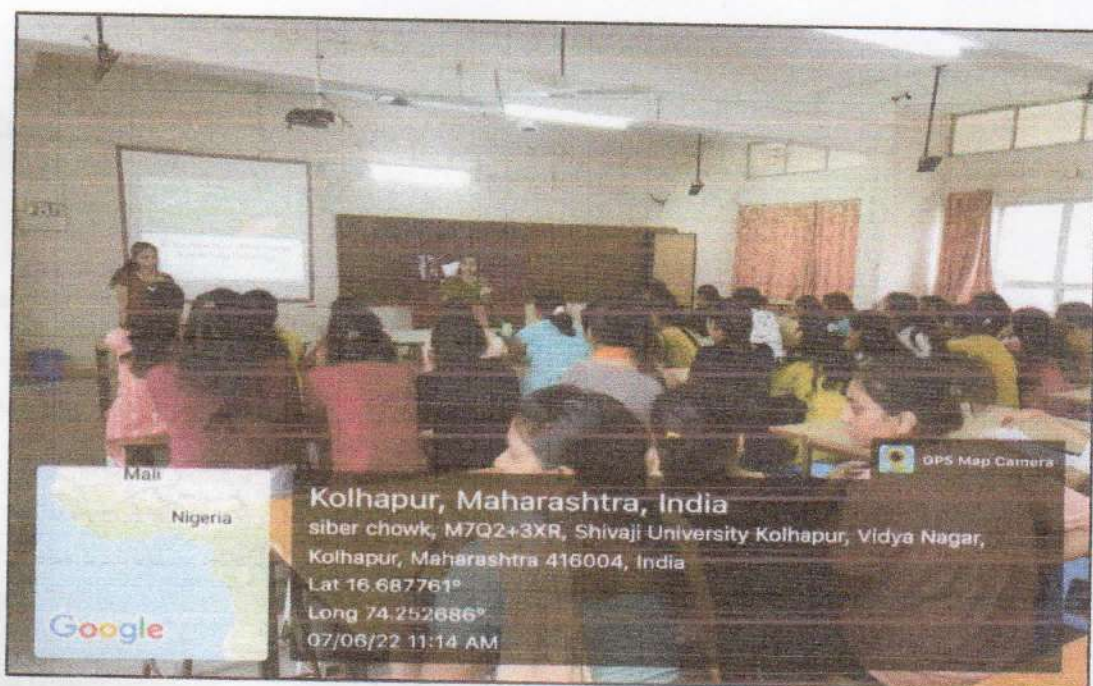
The Head of the Food Technology Department Mrs. Shweta Patil introduced the speaker Mrs. Yogita Mirajkar and gave an overview of the subject. Mrs. Yogita Mirajkar has been working as Assistant Professor for the last 2 years in the Food Technology Department and has qualified in UGC NET, ASRB – NET, SET, and recently has registered for a Ph.D. in Food Science and Technology. She is expert in the formulation of different food products. She first gave a brief idea about Entrance test for M. Sc. (FSN) and the pattern of questions for the test.

She explained the scope of M.Sc. (Food Science and Nutrition) in different sectors such as Government Jobs, Academic positions, Clinical positions, etc. As this program of M.Sc. (Food Science and Nutrition) covers Food processing as well as the Nutrition aspect of food, she gave an in-detail information about both these aspects. Students were made aware of the fact that they can work in the Food Industry as well as Nutritionists after completion of this Post Graduate degree program.

She also explained the Job opportunities in this field as Quality Manager, Scientific Laboratory Technician, Research Scientist, Consultancy, Toxicologist, etc. She focussed on the areas of Academic Positions such as Professor, Associate Professor, and Assistant Professor and the exams conducted by UGC and allied bodies. She also explained the R.D exam and licensing process for working as a Consulting Dietician. 51 students attended this session.

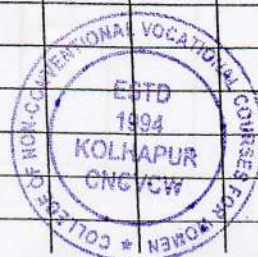

Outcomes:

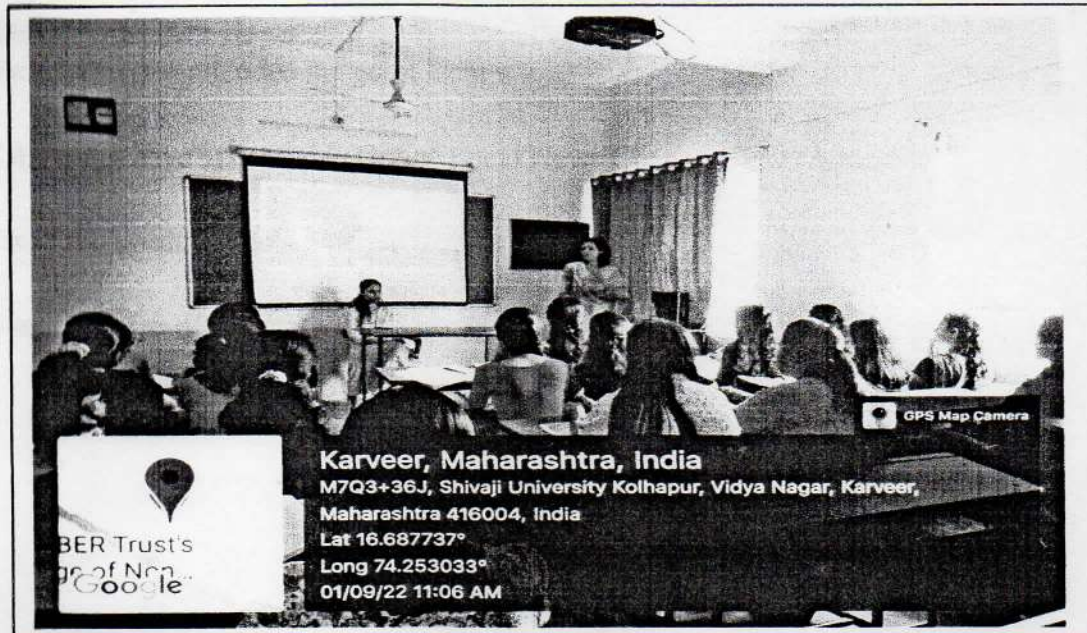
1. Students have gained the knowledge about different competitive exams in the field of Food and nutrition.
