









This was organized to know more about the Aari work needle and its handling Basic stitches for aari work.

Description- Aari work Add-on Course was conducted for the students of second year and third year. The students were taught 30 different stitches during the course. This course was organized to understand and know more about the art of aari work which is a craft that is practiced from Mughal period with different type of materials likes beads, sequins, zardosi, pipes, silk threads on various types of fabrics which can be converted into creative motifs for the surface embellishment. Zardosi embroidery material required for doing the work was brought by the students themselves. The needles were provided by the college. 
