Best Practice 1

Title of Best Practice

Health Checkup Camp

Objective of the Practice

To check blood parameters viz. haemoglobin and blood group of participants.

To provide medical advice and Diet consultation to participants.

The Context

Health Check-up camp provided an opportunity for the students to utilize their subject knowledge in facilitating the participants by checking body composition, blood group and haemoglobin levels.

The Practice

Health Check-up camp was organized by IQAC in collaboration with Department of Food Technology in which students of PGDND and M.Sc. (FSN) participated actively by checking body composition, blood group and haemoglobin levels of the participants and also provided advises on diet and health.

Evidence of Success


Total number of student volunteers was 12 and the participants were 41. Participants got to know about the vital nutrient level in blood i.e. Hb. The participants also received the diet and health advises. Feedback received was good.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required

The participants inquired for detailed, frequent health check-up and also asked to check the blood sugar.

More sophisticated equipments are required in number for a large scale check-up.



  
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### Best Practice 2

#### Title of Best Practice

Eco-friendly Lord Ganesh Idol Making.

#### Objective of the Practice

- To create awareness about eco-friendly Ganesh Chaturthi festival celebration and control water pollution.
- To make eco-friendly Ganesh idols from clay.

#### The Context

Ganesh idols made up of Plaster of Paris are sold in market that contaminates water reservoirs. Hence, college follows this best practice to celebrate the festival in an eco-friendly manner.

#### The Practice

Students are demonstrated with the idol making process. Students learn the idol making and apply their creative ideas in the same. The idols are made using clay. This creates a sense of awareness among the students regarding their responsibility towards protection of environment by reducing water pollution.

Healthy participation of students of different programmes proves the success of this best practice. A total 116 students participated in eco-friendly Ganesh idol making. Students became aware about environment friendly celebration and control of water pollution.

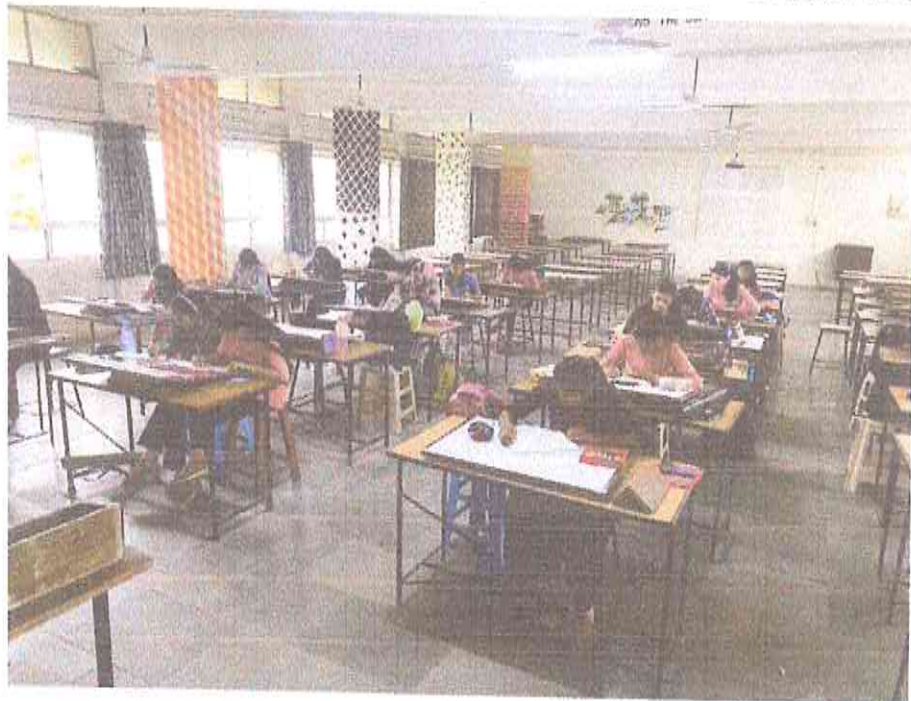

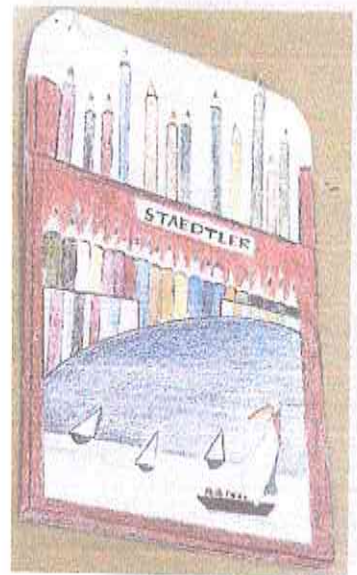

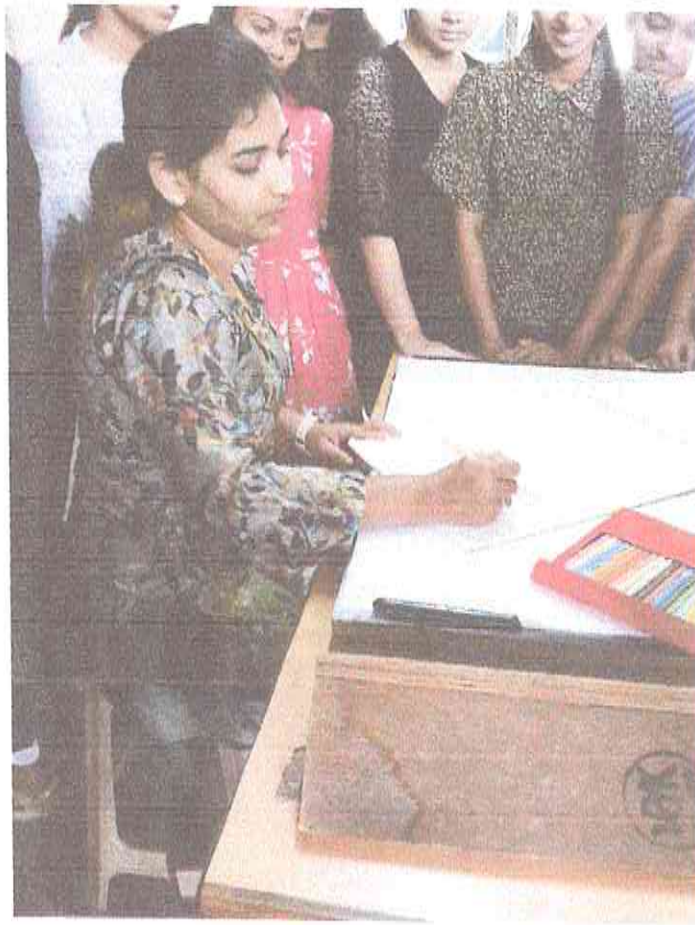
