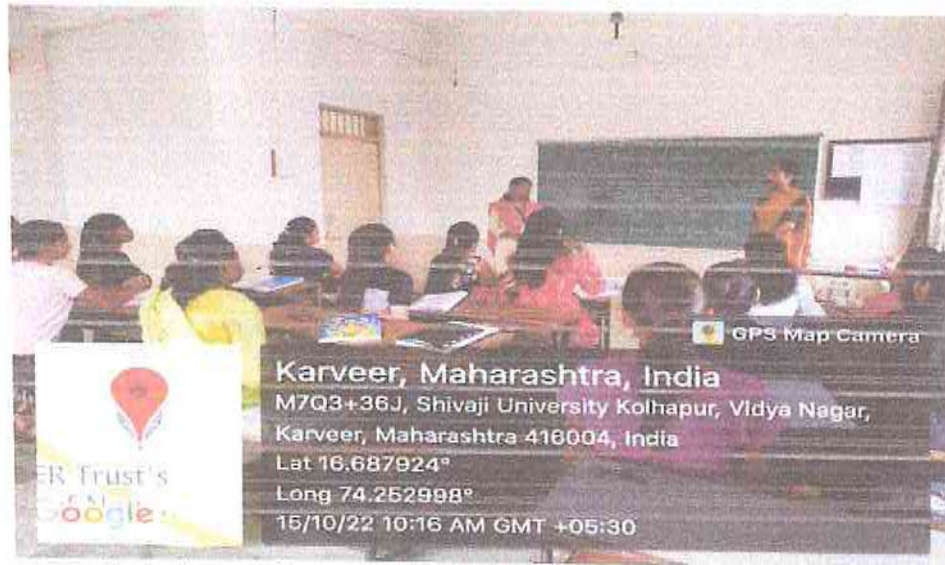

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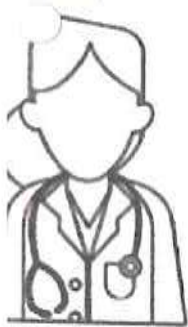

2. Participants came to know about their biochemical parameters like blood group and haemoglobin levels.




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3. Participants came to know about their body composition analysis.

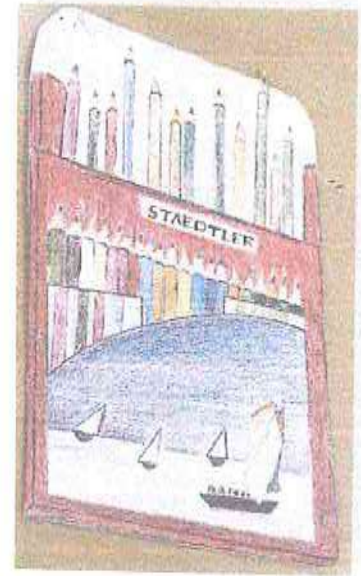

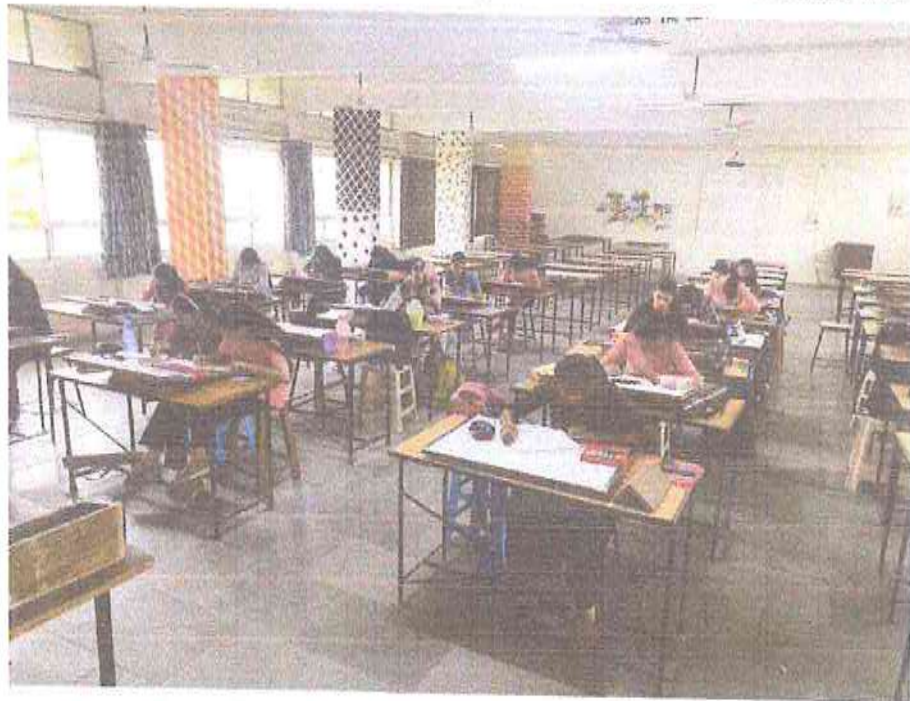

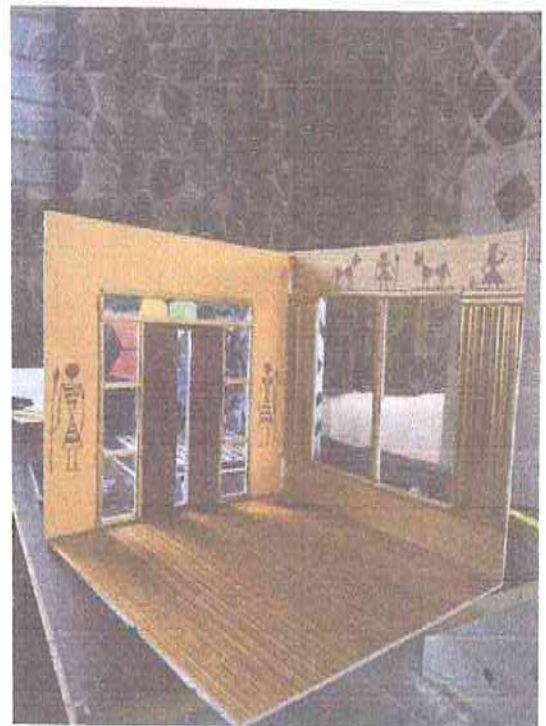
